2019: The Woodward Atrium

- A long-anticipated 1,300 square foot expansion that will enhance our ability to meet community needs for social gatherings, meetings and exhibition space.
 - An expansive multi-purpose event space
 - 2 conference rooms
 - Improved accessible parking
- This \$700,000 project is FULLY funded through the Library's fundraising from generous individual and foundation donors—not the town appropriation

The Main Library and Oakville Branch served 14,919 registered borrowers in 2018, posting attendance three times the town's population, and saw more than 74,000 items in circulation.

56% of Oakville and Watertown

residents have a library card





2010-2020: Town v. Library Budgets


